Jesus Christ succeeded.

Jesus said, "In my Father's house are many mansions." The glory of the mansion that we will receive is completely in the hands of Jesus Christ. It depends on how well we follow His word, use the talents we have been given and repent as we should in following Him.

Jesus Christ established His church and taught His gospel of how people should live .

After a few hundred years, many people have had different opinions on the words and meaning of His Gospel. Over the centurys, many different Christian denominations have been formed. They all claim their authority to be a different denomination to be based on the word of God.

There is opinion among some denominations that they are all equally right and acceptable in God's sight. However, they are not united as one in word and truth as all are called to be.

(New Testament | Ephesians 4:11 - 13)

11 And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers;

12 For the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ:

13 Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ:

(New Testament | Ephesians 4:2 - 7)

2 With all lowliness and meekness, with longsuffering, forbearing one another in love;

3 Endeavouring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.

4 *There is* one body, and one Spirit, even as ye are called in one hope of your calling;

5 One Lord, one faith, one baptism,

6 One God and Father of all, who *is* above all, and through all, and in you all.

7 But unto every one of us is given grace according to the measure of the gift of Christ.

We can all be grateful for His atonement through which we can repent and become perfect in following Jesus. We can have faith that all will receive a reward balanced with justice and mercy. By doing our best to follow Jesus Christ, we can have a greater faith that we will receive His gift of grace for a better inheritance in one of those heavenly mansion.

Through grace, we receive an inheritance in one of the many mansions prepared for us. Those who believe Jesus and have faith unto repentance and others who are not responsible for their acts, will inherit a mansion in heaven where Jesus is. Others, after they suffer somewhat as Jesus did for their sins, will inherit a lessor mansion of glory. Those who rebel against God and the witness of truth from the Holy Ghost, may never find forgiveness for any degree of glory.

God wants people to live righteously in serving the cause of justice, mercy, love and truth. In serving the cause of truth, consider the importance of sincerely striving to worship God in truth and serve God in truth.

(New Testament | Matthew 7:21 - 29)

21 Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.

22 Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works?

23 And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity.

24 Therefore whosoever heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them, I will liken him unto a wise man, which built his house upon a rock:

25 And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell not: for it was founded upon a rock.

26 And every one that heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them not, shall be likened unto a foolish man, which built his house upon the sand:

27 And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell: and great was the fall of it.

28 And it came to pass, when Jesus had ended these sayings, the people were astonished at his doctrine:

29 For he taught them as one having authority, and not as the scribes.

What might the people be guilty of in the above verses 21 and 22? Perhaps they put their own will above God's will. Perhaps they lack dedication and are lost in the ways of the world.

(New Testament | Matthew 13:44 - 46)

44 Again, the kingdom of heaven is like unto treasure hid in a field; the which when a man hath found, he hideth, and for joy thereof goeth and selleth all that he hath, and buyeth that field.

45 Again, the kingdom of heaven is like unto a merchant man, seeking goodly pearls:

46 Who, when he had found one pearl of great price, went and sold all that he had, and bought it.

Jesus Christ chose and ordained twelve Apostles giving them the authority to help build His church and teach His gospel.

Because of the need for proper authority, John The Baptist was chosen as the one who had the right to baptize Jesus Christ.

(New Testament | Hebrews 5:4 - 10)

4 And no man taketh this honour unto himself, but he that is called of God, as was Aaron.

5 So also Christ glorified not himself to be made an high priest; but he that said unto him, Thou art my Son, to day have I begotten thee.

6 As he saith also in another place, Thou art a priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec.

7 Who in the days of his flesh, when he had offered up prayers and supplications with strong crying and tears unto him that was able to save him from death, and was heard in that he feared;

8 Though he were a Son, yet learned he obedience by the things which he suffered;

9 And being made perfect, he became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey him;

10 Called of God an high priest after the order of Melchisedec.

(New Testament | Luke 20:1 - 8)

1 AND it came to pass, that on one of those days, as he taught the people in the temple, and preached the gospel, the chief priests and the scribes came upon him with the elders,

2 And spake unto him, saying, Tell us, by what authority doest thou these things? or who is he that gave thee this authority?

3 And he answered and said unto them, I will also ask you one thing; and answer me:

4 The baptism of John, was it from heaven, or of men?

5 And they reasoned with themselves, saying, If we shall say, From heaven; he will say, Why then believed ye him not?

6 But and if we say, Of men; all the people will stone us: for they be persuaded that John was a prophet.

7 And they answered, that they could not tell whence it was.

8 And Jesus said unto them, Neither tell I you by what authority I do these things.

Without doubt, the atonement satisfies the demands of justice for all sins, even for presumed authority sins. God's grace gives us life in the mansions prepared for us. The grace of His atonement for our sins makes possible His forgiveness of our sins. His gospel of truth includes our resurrection and the gift of a home in the heavenly mansions. Sincere repentance, seen in the intent of the heart, deserves grace for whatever gift of mansion we may be worthy of.
